**North Surrey Minor Football offers many programs year round**

#### **Spring Flag**

Spring Flag is a 5 on 5, non-contact flag football game that runs from April through June with the Provincial Championships in Kelowna in June.

*Spring Flag teams at North Surrey are Coach driven.* If you do not yet been asked to play on a team by a coach, you can add your name to our Player Pool list. This is a request only to play and does not guarantee you a team. You are not required to pay or register, until you have been added to a team. If a coach picks your name from the Player Pool, they will contact you directly.

#### **Spring Tackle**

This is new to the league and will be available for Bantam and Midget age groups. This program will run from March through June.

#### **Fall Football**

During the fall we offer Flag Football from players aged 5\* to 9 and Tackle football for players aged 10 – 18.

#### **Cheer**

We offer a Cheer Program for kids aged 5 – 18. Cheerleaders cheer for their respective Football teams on game day as well as compete in a league wide Cheer competition in November.

## VOLUNTEER POLICY

***Each family with a child playing or cheering is expected to volunteer. The team and squad managers will work with you to accommodate a schedule.***

Volunteering could include

\*At least three concession workers are in place. Concession workers must be 16 years old or older.

During the registration process, if a parent answers NO to the volunteer question, an additional \$100 will be added to their registration fees. \*This \$100 is not covered by any alternate funding programs and is non refundable.\*
